4. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN POLICIES

Neighbourhood planning provides the opportunity for communities to set out a positive vision for how they want their community to develop in the future in ways that meet identified local need and make sense for local people. The Wootton Neighbourhood Plan includes policies that will help deliver the vision and locations for small scale growth in line with community preferences.

The Policies that have been developed from the community engagement and evidence gathering processes are identified in **green shaded tables** and this consultation seeks to ensure that the Plan has been drafted in line with the views and requirements of the community.



NON-POLICY ACTIONS

The neighbourhood planning process has also a number of local issues and neighbourhood concerns (such as limited parking areas, speed awareness, promotion of village services etc) and, whilst these are not translated into strategic Neighbourhood Plan policies about the use and development of land, they represent matters that the Parish Council will be keen to consider further and seek to address over time and in liaison with other relevant stakeholders.

A number of non-policy actions have, therefore, been identified and these are identified in the **grey shaded tables** for the community to consider.
