POLICY W15

Local Facilities and Services

1. The identified community facilities are:
 - (a) Medical Health Centre;
 - (b) Wootton Library;
 - (c) Wootton Lower School (at both Bedford Road and Harris Way);
 - (d) Wootton Upper School;
 - (e) The Village Hall;
 - (f) Memorial Hall;
 - (g) The Community Centre;
 - (h) One Stop Wootton Store;
 - (i) Wootton Post Office;
 - (j) The Chequers Public House;
 - (k) The Cock Inn Public House;
 - (l) The Fox and Duck Public House;
 - (m) The Legstraps Public House;
 - (n) The Blue Cross Hall;
 - (o) Wootton Pharmacy;
 - (p) Wootton Garage (Fields Road);
 - (q) St. Mary's Church Hall;
 - (r) Wootton Community Nursery;
 - (s) Scout Hut (St. Mary's Road);
 - (t) Allotment Gardens (Hall End).
2. Development that would result in the loss of these community facilities will not be supported unless the following can be demonstrated:
 - (a) the proposals include alternative provision on a site within the SPA of equivalent or enhanced facilities. Such sites should be accessible by public transport, walking and cycling and have adequate car parking, or
 - (b) satisfactory evidence (including independently marketed for at least 12 months) to demonstrate that there is no longer an economic justification to protect the asset, or
 - (c) it can be demonstrated that the proposal would be of benefit to the local community and would outweigh the loss of the existing facility.
